- ✓ Provide any three transportation benefits from the list (if you have fewer than 25 employees, you need to provide only two benefits)
- ✓ Organize one Outreach Event annually (staff support resources available)
- ✓ Ensure easy employee access (online and/or in person) to available transportation benefits
- ✓ Meet with the Commute Friendly NC Program Coordinator for your region (look at our resources page to find yours)
- ✓ Fill out Biennial Commute Survey provided by the program

GOLD

- ✓ Provide any five transportation benefits from the list (if you have fewer than 25 employees, you need to provide only two benefits)
- ✓ Have a minimum of 10% (working towards 14%) non-drive alone commute trips
- ✓ Organize one Outreach Event annually (staff support resources available)
- ✓ Ensure easy employee access (online and/or in person) to available transportation benefits
- ✓ Meet with the Commute Friendly NC Program Coordinator for your region (look at our resources page to find yours)
- ✓ Fill out Biennial Commute Survey provided by the program
